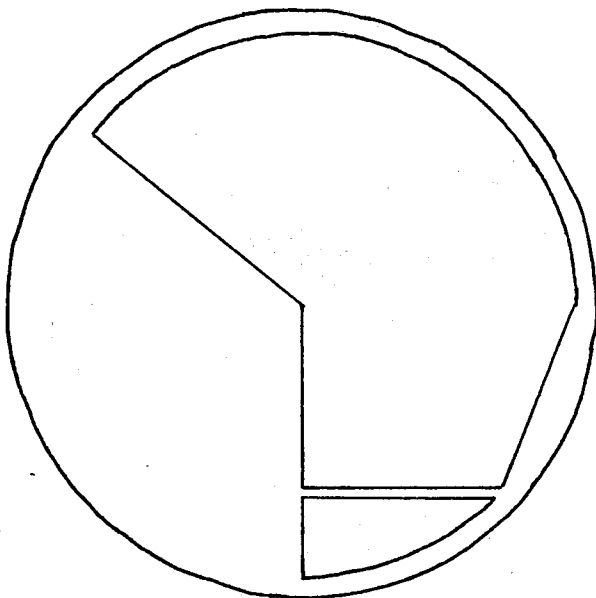
Introduction by Dario Fo

A few days before Christmas 15 years ago-on December 12, 1969-a bomb exploded in the Agricultural Bank in Milan. It was a massacre-more than 16 dead.The anarchists were immediately blamed for the slaughter.One of them,Giovanni Pinelli,having been taken to police headquarters,flew out of the window on the forth floor.The police declared that Pinelli had committed suicide after having been convinced that the real culprits were no other than Valpreda, Garganelli,and the other members of the Milan group.

SORRY!

Ten years later,at Catanzare in Southern Italy,the trial resulting from the slaughter in Milan came to an end. Three fascists were condemned to prison for being materially responsible for the crime.One of them, Giannettini,turned out to be an agent for the Italian secret police;it was thus confirmed beyond all doubt that the instigators of the crime had been the organisations entrusted with the "protection"of the Italian state.The instigators,as was clear from the sentence of the court,were to be found among the upper ranks of the military and political institutions.Ministers and generals were brought into court-but it all ended,as usual, in a great smoke-screen.Generals and ministers were first condemned and then acquitted.It was only the criminal "labour force" that went to prison.
